eMagazines for Kindle using the Nook App and downloading from **OVERDRIVE**

In order to read eMagazines on your Kindle Fire or Fire HD, a Nook App needs to be downloaded. This requires a couple of extra steps but only needs to be done one time.

What you will need:

- Wi Fi
- Kindle Fire or Fire HD

You will need to download **Easy Installer** and **1Mobile Market**. This will allow you to safely bypass the Amazon App Store (which does not currently offer the Nook App).

Next:

- Open the Amazon App Store.
- Search for Easy Installer and download.
- Close out of your Amazon App Store.
- Open Silk Browser and download 1Mobile Market.
- 1Mobile Market will download into the Easy Installer. It will prompt you to install and confirm installation. Confirm and download.
- If 1Mobile Market does not immediately open after installation or on your Kindle homepage, open it through Easy Installer (which will be located with your Apps on the Kindle home screen).
- Once opened, search for the Barnes and Noble Nook App and download.
- Upon download, open the Nook App and register with Barnes and Noble if you do not have an account. Your Nook App is now set up.

Next:

- Open your library's website at www.waterfordpubliclibrary.org. Tap on "eBooks & More", then select "Download eBooks and audiobooks"..

- Find a magazine. Once you've found a magazine select Get this issue. If prompted, sign in with your library card.
- Your library Bookshelf will open, displaying the magazine. From here, select Send to Nook. The first time you select Send to Nook, you'll be taken to a Barnes & Noble page where you'll be prompted to sign into your NOOK (Barnes & Noble.com) account. If you don't already have a free Nook account, you'll see a prompt to register for one.
- After you've signed into (or created) your Nook account, select Grant Access. This is a one-time step that allows magazines in your library account to be sent to your Nook device or app.
- Once the magazine has been successfully sent to Nook, it will automatically be removed from your library account within a few minutes. This frees up space in your library account so you can get other magazines.
- If the magazine was *not* successfully sent to your Nook account, you can select Re-send to Nook to try again, or you can select Clear from Bookshelf to manually remove it from your library account.
- You'll find the periodical that you sent to Nook in your Nook reading app or supported Nook device.

Periodicals that you send to Nook will stay in your Nook app or on your Nook forever (unless you manually remove them). You don't have to worry about returning them to your library, and you'll never be charged for them.
