The application may be completed in advance by going to www.waterfordct.org and then going to the Waterford Youth Services page, printing the application, completing the application, and presenting it, in-person, with the following documentation: a photo ID and 2 pieces of current Waterford mail for each adult in the household. For residents who do not have internet access, applications may be completed at Youth Services and are still required to present the needed documentation.
