**Fantastic Friends** Storytime welcomes all 3 to 5 year olds to participate in an interactive storytime with a craft! Registration is not required, however space is limited.

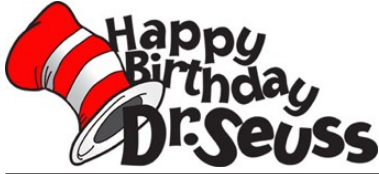
