Chairman Green called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm.

CITIZEN SESSION

Paul Geraghty addressed the Commission as a representative of the Friends of Oswegatchie Hills to seek information on Waterford Utility Commission comments regarding the issue of sewer connection for the proposed development by Landmark. Chairman Green informed Mr. Geraghty that in the past he had discussed water connections with Wayne Frazier of East Lyme but had not discussed issues of sewer connection. Attorney Kepple stated that WUC will make comment when it has received the plans for the development in order to review the technical details.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

- ENTERPRISE FUND REVENUES/EXPENDITURES & FINANCIAL REPORT-CAPITAL PROJECTS
Mr. Soto reviewed the financial reports with the Commission; the billing from New London for Treatment Costs has not been received. New London is waiting for their audit report before sending the bill for treatment.
- WASTEWATER STATIONS/SCADA
Mr. Soto reported that the SCADA RFP may be completed within the next 2 weeks and he anticipates the bid opening may occur near the end of June to beginning of July.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- ON-GOING PROJECTS UPDATE – BOLLES CT PS/BUE HILLS PS
Mr. Soto reported that the Bolles Ct upgrade is approximately 90% complete and presently is working on the punch list items.

Mr. Soto distributed copies of the Blue Hills Pump Station Upgrade Bid Tabulation to the Commission. The Commission reviewed the report and discussed the Blue Hills Project.

MOTION made by Mr. Kirkman to accept the lowest bid made by Lombardi Gravel & Excavation LLC, for \$963,000.00 and to authorize Mr. Soto to request appropriation from the Board of Finance for full funding of the project. Seconded by Mr. Negri.

- TOWN PURCHASING ORDINANCE UPDATE
Mr. Soto reported to the Commission that the RTM subcommittee had unanimously recommended the change to the Purchasing Ordinance go to a Public Hearing on June 1, 2015.

- CT DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH – PWSID UPDATE
Chairman Green informed the Commission that responses have been sent for all changes requested by the State, now waiting for the State's reply.
- NEW LONDON/VEOLIA REPORT
Mr. Soto reported that he had not received the monthly report from Veolia but he will distribute the report to the Commission as soon as he receives.
